

The Carriage of Dangerous Goods and Use of Transportable Pressure Equipment Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2010 (as amended)

Authorisation No. 970

Applicable to Carriage by Road Only

This authorisation is given in accordance with Regulation 9 of The Carriage of Dangerous Goods and Use of Transportable Pressure Equipment Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2010 (as amended) (CDG 2010).

PURPOSE

To allow dangerous goods to be carried without the driver being in possession of their ADR Driver Training Certificate, where the driver holds a valid Certificate and ADR 8.1.2.2 (b) would otherwise require the Certificate to be present on the transport unit.

TIME LIMIT

This authorisation has immediate effect and shall remain in force until 30th June 2021 unless withdrawn or otherwise revoked.

ALTERNATIVE CARRIAGE PROVISIONS

- 1. This authorisation is limited to use only on roads in Northern Ireland.
- The driver of the vehicle must hold a valid ADR Driver Training Certificate, which can be verified through the Scottish Qualifications Authority (SQA) using the following contact address <u>adr@sqa.org.uk</u>.
- 3. If an ADR enforcement check is made during carriage, the driver must show this authorisation to the enforcing officer together with a photographic means of identification.
- 4. A copy of this Authorisation shall be carried in the cab of the vehicle on each individual carriage operation.
- 5. All other provisions of CDG 2010 must be complied with at all times.
