

**The Carriage of Dangerous Goods and Use of Transportable Pressure
Equipment Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2010**

Authorisation No. 38

Applicable to carriage by road and rail

This authorisation is given in accordance with regulation 9 (1) of The Carriage of Dangerous Goods and Use of Transportable Pressure Equipment Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2010 (The Carriage Regulations).

PURPOSE


A transitional measure for alternative labelling requirements for clinical waste packaged in accordance with packing instructions IBC 620 or LP 621, subject to meeting the alternative carriage provisions given below.

TIME LIMIT

This authorisation comes into effect immediately and remains valid until 31 December 2015 for the use of packaging.

ALTERNATIVE CARRIAGE PROVISIONS

1. The outer packaging shall be UN approved plastic INCs or wheeled bins constructed on or before 31 December 2006*.
2. The model 6.2 labels required by chapter 5.2 of RID and ADR may be varied as follows:-
 - the border, symbol and relevant inscriptions shall be in black and shall be permanently embossed on to the packaging
 - the background colour may be that of the packaging provided there is adequate contrast.
3. If the legibility of an embossed label is impaired the packaging shall be withdrawn from use.
4. All other relevant provisions of the Carriage Regulations shall be complied with.
